

Brunk Industries Conflict Free Minerals Policy

To support the humanitarian goal of ending violent conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries, Brunk Industries is seeking to procure “DRC Conflict Free” materials whenever possible for use in our products.

We are in the process of performing due diligence with respect to our supply chain in order to confirm that tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold used in our products are sourced from:

1. smelters outside the DRC, **or**
2. smelters in the DRC who are certified as “DRC Conflict Free.”

As a part of our commitment to this policy, initial actions include:

- We will request that our suppliers provide documentation of the origin of tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold used in the products supplied to Brunk Industries.
- We will share Conflict-Free status information with our customers and take appropriate actions if any sources are found to be “Non-Conflict Free.”
- We will not knowingly procure specified metals that originate in the DRC that are not certified as “Conflict Free.”

Brunk Industries expects suppliers to establish policies and due diligence methods to reasonably assure us of the Conflict Free status of the items we procure. Suppliers are also expected to support Brunk’s environmental strategies, including efforts to reduce operating costs, minimize environmental footprint, and engage in ethical business practices.
